The end result is arguably one of the finest Superyachts to have ever been built, and this is credited by her awards: World Superyacht Awards (WSA) Sailing Yacht of the Year 2011, WSA Sailing Yacht 45m+ 2011, Showboats Design Awards 2011 for Exterior Design and Styling, Showboats Design Awards 2011 for Crew and Service Areas, Nautical Design Awards Innovation Award 2011 to name a few.

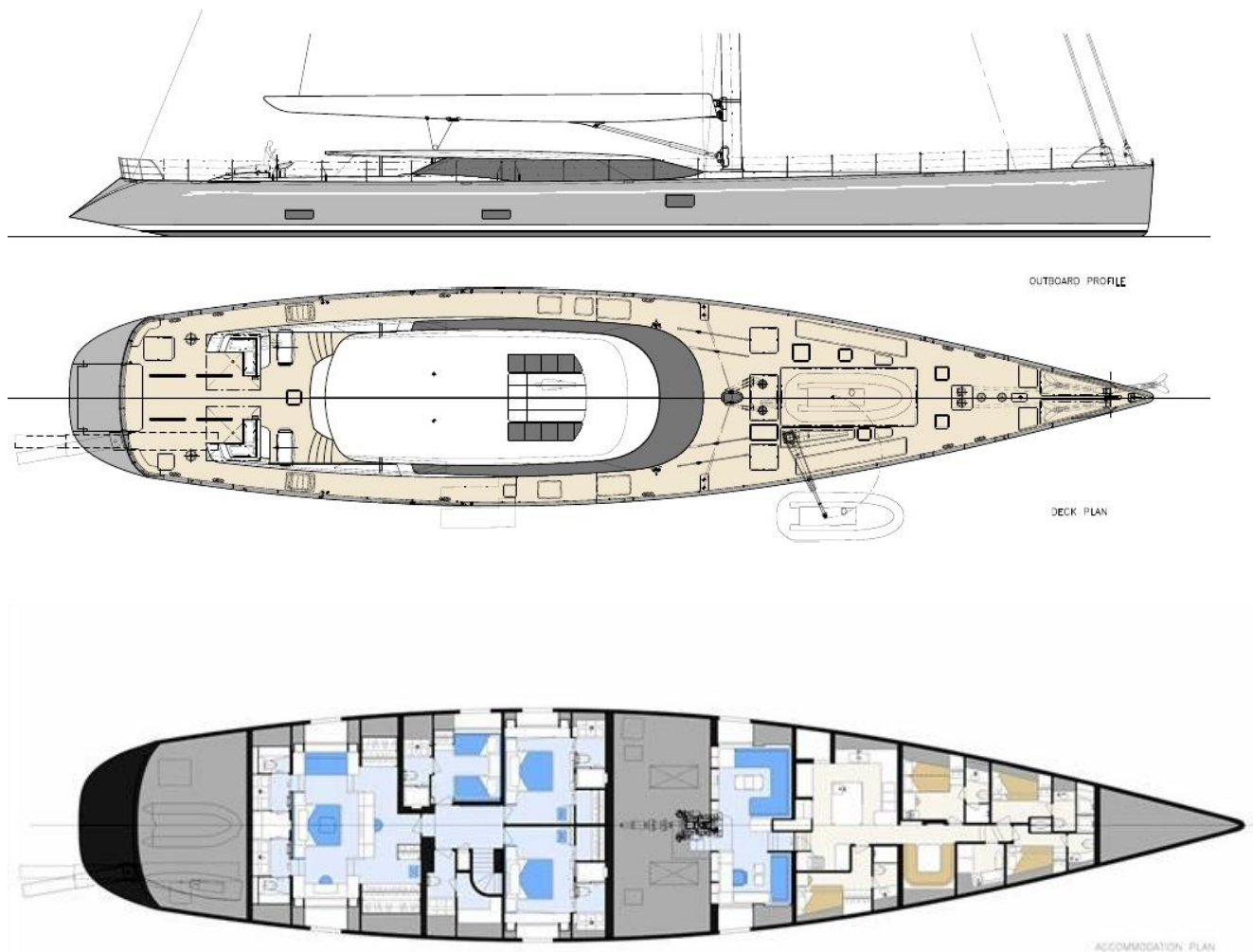
The accommodation throughout the yacht features a stunning interior designed by Remi Tessier. The flooring is bleached Wenge, complimented perfectly by the sycamore walls and ceilings with a water

matt finish. The overall effect is a minimal and light “pure harmonious” interior. In addition to the woodwork and joinery, the leatherwork and soft furnishings combine with ornate glass and mirrors, all strategically placed to create a feeling of space and comfort throughout the yacht. One of the key aspects was to maintain a single level between bridge, saloon and cockpit, thus maintaining her low profile and open feeling. In particular the use of space in the galley and crew areas – dear to the owner’s heart – creates an exceptional volume and range of amenities.

The performance of **Zefira** as both a cruising yacht and a competitor on the Superyacht regatta circuit was also of utmost importance to her Owners. In particular performance in light breezes was a major requirement that is certainly met, as is her performance and stability in stronger conditions where speeds in excess of 18 knots are common.

The combination of all these attributes makes **Zefira** the most exciting yacht to come to the market in recent times. Inspections are strongly recommended.

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
